Financial Support for Families

Lilydale High School understand that some families may experience financial difficulty and offers a range of support options, including:

- **Camps, Sports and Excursions (CSEF)** – for eligible families. To be eligible for the fund a parent or guardian of a student attending a registered Government or non Government school must be a holder of Veteran Affairs Gold Card OR be an eligible Centrelink Health Care Card OR Pensioner Concession Card holder OR be a temporary foster parent.
- **State Schools Relief** – clothing/uniforms via Student Services.
